- **KANSAS MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR BOUNDARY SURVEYS & MORTGAGEE TITLE INSPECTIONS:**

Bill Haverkamp, L.S.

This is a review of the Kansas Minimum Standards as adopted by the Kansas State Board of Technical Professions.

Bill Haverkamp, L.S., is the Survey Coordinator for the Kansas Department of Transportation Bureau of Design. He began his surveying career in 1977 on a KDOT preliminary design crew, became licensed in 1986, and has been in his present position since Nov, 1990. He is past president and board member of the Kansas Society of Land Surveyors.

- **SUBDIVISION PLATTING AND SITE PLAN REVIEW PROCESS:**

The process towards finalizing a subdivision plat has many steps that are common in most municipalities. David will be explaining the process to work a plat and site plan through the Topeka system.

David Thurbon has been the planning director for the City of Topeka since 2002. The planning department is responsible for zoning, subdivision plats, landscape and site plan reviews, historic preservation, annexation issues, long range land use plans, and neighborhood planning. Prior to moving to Topeka, David served as planning director in San Angelo, Texas and Assistant Director in Midland, Texas. He was born and raised in western Pennsylvania and has a Masters Degree in City Planning from the University of Pittsburgh.

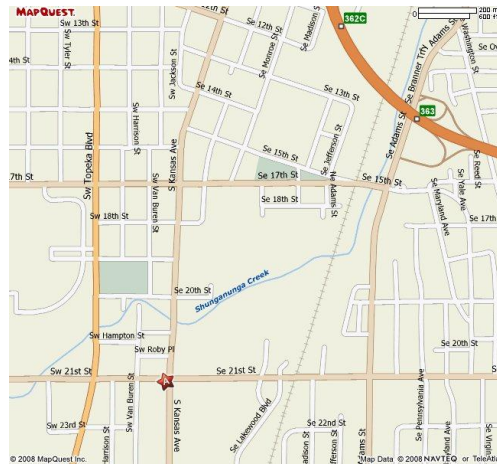
