Ron Feldkamp, P.S.

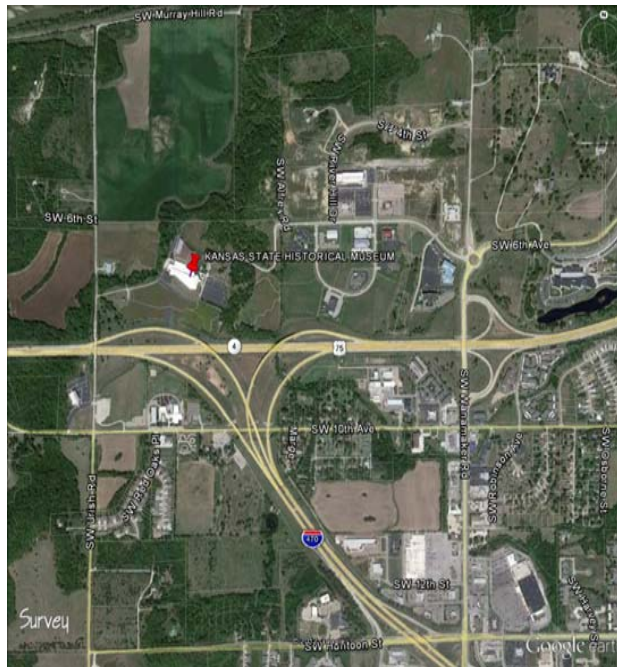
